Purpose

Provide information about the Ontario Energy Support Program (OESP) for tenants.

Background

The Ontario Energy Board is introducing the Ontario Electricity Support Program (OESP) in January 2016. The OESP directly reduces the electricity bills of low-income customers.

Eligible customers can save between \$30 and \$50 on their electricity bills depending on their income and household size. If the customer pays for electric heat or relies on medical devices requiring a lot of electricity, OESP offers higher levels of assistance.

Tenant Applications

Tenants and co-op members, who directly pay their own electricity costs, can apply for the program beginning in late October 2015. Eligible tenants and co-op members will see a direct reduction in their electricity bills beginning in January 2016.
