Please find enclosed, your Special Needs Resourcing (SNR) services information package. This package was developed collaboratively between Durham SNR agencies and the Regional Municipality of Durham, Social Services Department, Children's Services Division.

The modernization of SNR Services in Durham has occurred to keep pace with the Ministry of Education direction to deliver in-scope services, the Special Needs Resourcing in Durham Region (2017) report and to support the changing needs of the early learning community. Notably, changes to service delivery include shifting the focus to support Individual Service Plans (ISP's) for all children requiring additional programming and enhancing the development and delivery of educator-centered services. These services are intended to support educators as they meet the unique learning needs of every child. The information provided in this resource package outlines the SNR services and supports available to educators, and how to access them.
