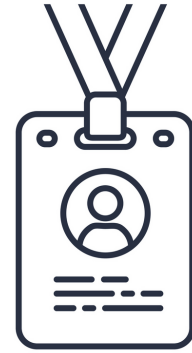


Protect Your Digital Identity.

What is a digital ID?

It's a way to prove your identity online. It also protects your personal data by making sure that only the right people have access to it.

Keep a clean machine.

Protect your devices against security flaws by keeping all software up to date.

Monitor your credit reports.

Accounts you don't recognize could be a sign of identity theft.

Create strong passwords.

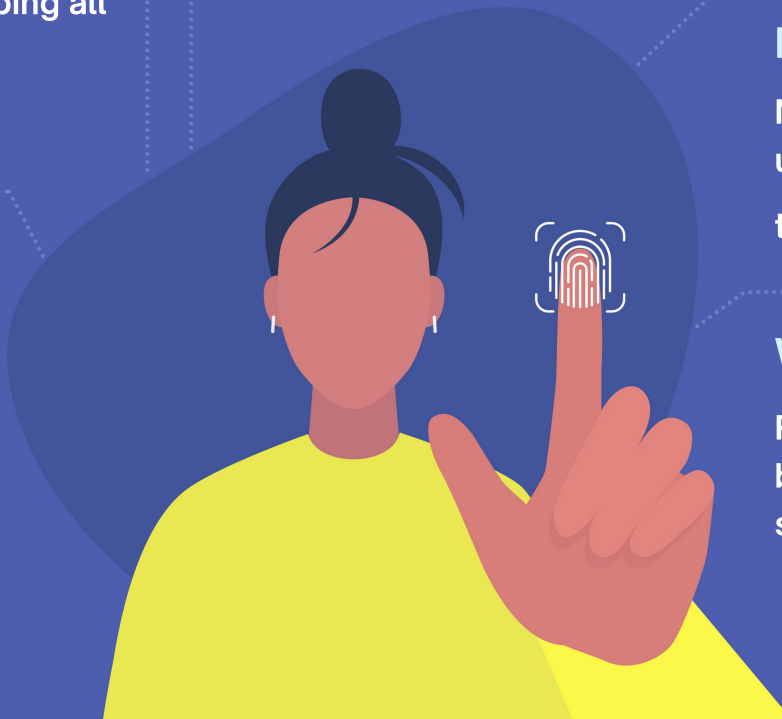
Use long and unique passphrases for your accounts and multifactor authentication (MFA) where possible.

Don't take the bait.

Never click on links unless you're sure they're legitimate.

Wi-Fi Danger.

Public Wi-Fi may not be secure. Avoid it for sensitive transactions.
