## Book your COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment Now!

The Durham Region vaccine clinic at the Lakeridge Health Oshawa location is open. **You/your office staff have been identified as an eligible population to receive the Pfizer vaccine** based on [guidance from the Ministry of Health](#). This means you belong to one of the following groups:

- 1) Primary care provider (physicians or nurse practitioners) or office staff
- 2) Community based medical specialists (physicians) or office staff
- 3) Pharmacist or pharmacy staff (those who work directly in the pharmacy)
- 4) Lab/Diagnostic services – health care provider or office staff
- 5) Walk-in clinic staff or office staff
- 6) Dentistry/Oral surgeon or office staff
- 7) Midwife practice or office staff
- 8) NP-led clinic staff or office staff
- 9) Community Health Centre staff or office staff
- 10) Firefighters (medical first responders)
- 11) Police (who act as medical first responders)

**Please note that all who come for an appointment will be required to show proof that they are a member of the current priority populations and that they live or work in Durham Region.**

Acceptable proof of belonging to the priority group includes a professional credential, ID badge or pay stub, and acceptable proof of Durham residency includes driver's license, tax bill, and credit card or bank statements.

**If you are not currently seeing clients in the office and are working completely remotely, please allow your colleagues to register for the vaccine at this time.**

If you have received this Fax about but are not part of the currently eligible population, we will provide information as soon as possible about when you will be prioritized to receive vaccine.
