Vaccinations usually cause NO major side effects. **Side effects after vaccination may include:** Soreness, redness or swelling at the injection site (a cold, wet compress on the affected area may help), slight fever, headache, muscle aches &/or malaise (acetaminophen can help minimize pain, fever &/or swelling). If you think a serious reaction is developing, seek medical attention right away. **Unusual** or **significant** changes in your health or your child's health should be reported to a doctor and Durham Region Health Department.
