COVID-19 Vaccine Booking for Adult Recipients of Chronic Home Care

Individuals who receive chronic home care and are 16 years of age and older are now eligible to register for Pfizer vaccine based on the [provincial three-phased vaccine distribution implementation plan](#).

These bookings can occur immediately. You may book your vaccine appointment this weekend through the Health Department (<https://www.durham.ca/en/health-and-wellness/resources/Documents/Novel-Coronavirus/Vaccine-Booking/Priority-Populations.pdf>) for the Pickering Chestnut Hills Development Recreation Complex or through Lakeridge Health ([COVIDvaccine.lh.ca](https://www.lakeridgehealth.ca/covidvaccine)) for the Durham College and Ontario Tech University site.

Individuals will need to provide proof that they are adult chronic home care recipients. Examples of proof include: a letter from the local LHIN (e.g. from a welcome package or any other correspondence), or a letter from a funding organization (if hiring their own home care supports).

Unfortunately, family members and caregivers are not eligible at this time, but should be shortly once Phase 2 vaccination is underway.

Additional municipal locations will be opening in the coming days and weeks depending on vaccine availability. We will provide additional opening and booking information as soon as it is available.
