## Healthy Babies Healthy Children Program

This program aims to support families with their parenting goals in the prenatal and post-partum period as well as throughout early child development up until school entry.

Having a baby can be both an exciting and challenging time for new parents. Public health nurses and family visitors offer information and support to families through telephone calls and home visits. Home visits will be offered Monday to Friday 8:30am to 4:30pm.
