# Monkeypox Educational Webinar for Health Care Providers – July 19, 2022

Ontario HIV Treatment Network (OHTN) is presenting a new webinar - **Monkeypox: How to Recognize It, How to Manage It - What Primary Care Physicians and Clinicians in Ontario Need to Know.**
