This FSP will list your priorities for your child's development and will include strategies that work within your family's routines. The FSP may change based on your priorities during service.

- What would you like to work on right now?
- What parts of your routine are going well?

### **Family Interview**

At the time of intake you complete the Family Interview over the phone.

#### 1st Home Visit

You and the Consultant talk about your child's development and priorities within your daily routines.



You and the Consultant create the FSP together listing your priorities and supporting strategies.

#### **Ongoing Home Visits**

You and the Consultant use the FSP to guide visits to support your priorities with your child's development.

#### Service Completed

Service is completed when FSP priorities have been supported and a plan for future priorities has been discussed.
