Observed the bathroom sink being used as a reprocessing sink. Observed furnishings and surfaces made of absorbent materials and/or in poor repair. Observed pedicure foot graters being disinfected with an inadequate level disinfectant. Observed two used nail buffers and a used nail file at workstations.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator must ensure equipment cleaning/reprocessing sink is not located in a washroom.
- Operator must provide furnishings and surfaces in good repair, easily cleanable, smooth and/or impermeable.
- Operator must disinfect pedicure foot graters with high-level disinfectant after each use.
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
