Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Observed debris in paraffin wax warming pot. Observed used, single-use nail buffers and files in storage. Required records, documentation and after-care instructions were not available for micropigmentation service. Invoices/receipts were not available for prepackaged, sterile needle cartridges used for micropigmentation service. Written notification was not provided to health department prior to adding additional personal services. Non-porous foot files and brushes stored in bleach water solution. Re-usable equipment not properly cleaned and disinfected.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to dispense products in a manner to prevent contamination.
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to provide proper aftercare instructions to clients for invasive services.
- Operator to maintain client records for invasive services.
- Operator to maintain records for items purchased as pre-packaged and sterile.
- Operator to provide at least 14 days written notice to the health department before providing additional personal services.

- Operator to ensure reusable items that are not cleaned immediately after each use are soaked in a labelled, covered container.
- Operator to clean re-usable equipment prior to disinfection.
