Operator not properly covering the area of the body where the invasive service is being performed. Written aftercare instructions not provided to client. Incomplete client records.

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to ensure a dedicated equipment cleaning sink with continuous, potable, hot and cold running water, under pressure is provided.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all work surfaces and equipment that come into contact with a client after each use.
- Operator to use individually packaged dressing or bandage intended for covering tattoo wounds.
- Operator to ensure proper written aftercare instructions are provided to all clients.

• Operator to ensure the appropriate client records are maintained for invasive procedures, including lot numbers and expiry dates of pre-packaged sterile equipment and the body part/ area on which the procedure was performed on.
