Observed single-use items not being discarded immediately after each client. Observed nail tools/equipment/surfaces/linens improperly cleaned, disinfected and/ or laundered. Observed nail implements and items improperly stored. Incomplete high-level disinfection (HLD) records. Chemical bottles not labelled appropriately.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to ensure clean sheets, linen, towels, etc. maintained in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to store items and nail implements in clean, covered containers.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable implements after each use.
- Operator to ensure all implements are properly disinfected with an appropriate level of disinfectant.

- Operator must apply disinfectants for the proper contact time as per the manufacturer's instructions.
- Operator to ensure chemical containers are properly labelled.
- Operator to ensure HLD disinfection records are maintained.
