How the potential IPAC lapse was identified: Complaint

Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Observed clean nail implements and wax pots not being stored in a clean and sanitary manner. Observed reusable items not being cleaned and disinfected immediately after each use. Observed used nail implements and foot baths being improperly cleaned and disinfected. Observed ready-to-use disinfectant being diluted. Observed disinfectant being applied to aesthetic implements for an insufficient contact time. Appropriate level disinfectant unavailable for disinfection of re-usable grater style foot files. Observed alcohol disinfectant solution with debris. Observed used, single-use buffer blocks, files and sand bands stored in manicure stations. Observed aesthetics bed linens to be soiled and being laundered at the end of the day. Observed wooden and plastic spoons used to dispense foot soak/scrub stored directly in the product.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to store items in clean, covered containers and/or in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to soak all reusable implements that cannot be cleaned and disinfected immediately after use in a labelled, covered container.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable implements and equipment after each use.

- Operator to prepare disinfectants as per manufacturer's instructions.
- Operator to apply disinfectants for the proper contact time as per manufacturer's instructions.
- Operator to ensure all implements are disinfected with an appropriate level of disinfectant.
- Operator to discard disinfectant solutions as required.
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to launder linens, sheets, towels, etc. after each use.
- Operator to store and dispense products in a manner to prevent from contamination.
