How the potential IPAC lapse was identified: Complaint

Summary description of the IPAC lapse:

Observed instruments, equipment, and surfaces to be dirty and/or not being properly cleaned and disinfected. Observed reusable tools not being stored in a sanitary manner. Observed furnishings and equipment made of absorbent material/not maintained in good condition. Observed single-use items not discarded immediately after each client. Operator stated they would reuse a wax applicator (i.e., double dipping). A dedicated hand wash sink was not provided in an area where personal services are offered. No notification to the Health Department of renovations and addition of services.

IPAC Lapse Investigation

Did the IPAC lapse involve a member of a regulatory college? No

Concise description of the corrective measures required:

- Operator to ensure all surfaces are kept clean and in a sanitary manner.
- Operator to ensure all surfaces and furnishings are made of durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and easy to clean material.
- Operator to discard all single-use items immediately after each use, and not reuse or share between clients.
- Operator to clean reusable implements by using a clean, dedicated brush with detergent and water and friction to remove debris prior to disinfection.

- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all reusable implements after each use.
- Operator to properly clean and disinfect all foot baths after each client.
- Operator to store reusable aesthetic tools and hair tools in clean, covered containers.
- Operator to provide a hand washing sink conveniently located to the work area.
- Operator to dispense wax in a manner that prevents contamination (e.g., no double dipping).
- Operator to provide at least 14 days written notice to the health department before commencing renovations and/or providing additional personal services.
