## CAMH Online Courses

The Centre for Addictions and Mental Health (CAMH) has two upcoming educational opportunities: [Opioid Use Disorder Treatment Course](#) and [Recovery-Oriented Approach Course](#).

### Opioid Use Disorder Treatment Course

This course will prepare learners to safely and effectively manage the treatment of clients who are receiving methadone or buprenorphine for opioid use disorder. The course will also promote interprofessional collaboration among the health care team involved in the delivery of opioid dependence treatment. Pharmacists who complete this course **will be in compliance with the Ontario College of Pharmacists' policy regarding required training.**

- Dates: **January 13 – April 20, 2025**
- Course duration: **7-8 weeks**
- Cost: **\$525**
- **Intended Audience: Physicians; nurse practitioners; pharmacists; counsellors; nurses, anyone in the field of opioid use treatment.**
- College of Family Physicians of Canada Mainpro+ Self-Learning: **Eligible for 20 credits.**

### Recovery Oriented Approach Course

This course is part of the Concurrent Disorders Certificate (CD) and the Opioid Treatment (ODT) Certificate Program. It is designed for **mental health, addiction and allied health professionals** who have completed the Concurrent Disorders Core Course and who have experience working with clients with concurrent disorders. The course aims to help learners further their understanding of the recovery-oriented approach. **This seven-week course consists of seven modules, allowing learners to focus on one module per week.**

- Dates: **January 13 - March 9, 2025**
- Course duration: **7 weeks**
- Cost: **\$425**
- College of Family Physicians of Canada Mainpro+ Self-Learning: **Eligible for 21.5 credits.**
- Course Requirements and Prerequisites: **This course can be taken alone; however, it qualifies as an elective for the Concurrent Disorders Certificate Program and the Opioid Treatment Certificate Program.**
