Help celebrate educators: 2025 Prime Minister's Awards nominations

The nomination period for the 2025 <u>Prime Minister's Awards</u> is now open. The Prime Minister's Awards are a chance to celebrate educators for their leadership and exemplary education practices. Any person or group (i.e., parents, colleagues, principals, board members, or students) can nominate educators in three different categories:

- Teaching excellence
- Teaching excellence in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics
- Excellence in early childhood education

Ontario ECE grants will begin accepting applications for the winter 2025 semester from previous ECE applicants as of November 18.
