Key highlights:

Regional Council approved report <u>2024-SS-10</u> to receive provincial funding provided through the Ministry of Education for the Canada-Wide Early Learning and Child Care System for staffing, operating and capital costs.

Council approved <u>2024-SS-12</u> to advance detailed project design services for the redevelopment of the Durham Regional Local Housing Corporation property at 409 Centre Street in Whitby.

Council approved report <u>2024-W-22</u> to renew lease space at 419 King Street West in Oshawa for the continued operation of a Sexual Health Clinic run by the Durham Region Health Department.

Council approved report <u>2024-COW-41</u>, as amended, enlarging the size of Phase 1 Seaton Prestige Employment Lands area to 160 hectares (396 acres) to advance water and wastewater servicing projects in the area.

A Transfer Payment Agreement with the Ministry of the Solicitor General for funding for a police helicopter for the Durham Regional Police Service Joint Air Support Unit was approved. See report <u>2024-COW-42</u> for details.
