


The Regional Municipality of Durham



2020 Gross Budgets - \$1.8 Billion

Water and sanitary sewer services: \$358.0 million, with user rates funding \$217.7 million of these costs. These services are not funded from property taxes.


Property tax supported services: \$1.4 billion, with property taxes funding \$698.3 million of these costs.



2020 Water And Sanitary Sewer User Rate Supported Services

It costs about \$358.0 million to provide water supply and sanitary sewer services. These services are funded, in part, by the people who use them through user rates. No property taxes are used to fund these services.

2020 Property Tax Supported Services

Annual property taxes are collected from property owners in Durham Region based on each property's current value assessment (CVA), as provided by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC). The property class tax rates are approved by the Region, local municipalities and the province (for education purposes).
