
2019 BUSINESS PLANS AND BUDGETS

The Region of Durham budgets for the following two types of services which total \$1.6 billion:


Water and sanitary sewer services: 2019 budgeted gross expenditures of \$417.3 million; with user rates funding \$210.1 million of these expenditures. These services are not funded from property taxes.

Property tax supported services: 2019 budgeted gross expenditures of \$1.2 billion; with property taxes funding \$669.1 million of these expenditures.

2019 WATER AND SANITARY SEWER USER RATE SUPPORTED SERVICES


Water and sanitary sewer services are provided under a user pay system where individual customers are charged based on metered water consumption.

2019 AVERAGE HOME USAGE

The average home uses 221 cubic metres of water in a year.

The average annual home billing is \$952 for water and sanitary sewer services.

The 2019 increase is 1.8 per cent or \$17 per year for the average home.



2019 BUDGET SUMMARY

The 2019 budgeted gross expenditures total \$417.3 million.





2019 PROPERTY TAX SUPPORTED SERVICES

Annual property taxes are collected from property owners in Durham Region based on each property's current value assessment (CVA), as provided by the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC). The property class tax rates are approved by the Region, local municipalities and the province (for education purposes).


